What are they?

Ara has several spaces available in our Long-term Independent Dwellings (LIDs). These are small, shared properties for people ready to move out of supported accommodation and take the next step in their lives.

These are available long-term and provide safe and stable accommodation for people to start living independently. The rents are at a rate which is affordable so people can start working when appropriate.

There will also be a service charge to cover utilities.

What you will receive

You will have your own lockable room in a shared house and will share kitchen, living room, bathroom and laundry facilities with others in the house. Accommodation is provided part-furnished (e.g. white goods and larger items of furniture).

You should be able to access short-term resettlement support provided by Live West to help you settle into your accommodation.

Eligibility

To be eligible you need to:

- Be able to maintain your own accommodation and live independently
- Be able to share with others in the house
- Pay a deposit of £300, preferably upfront but this can be paid over time if required
