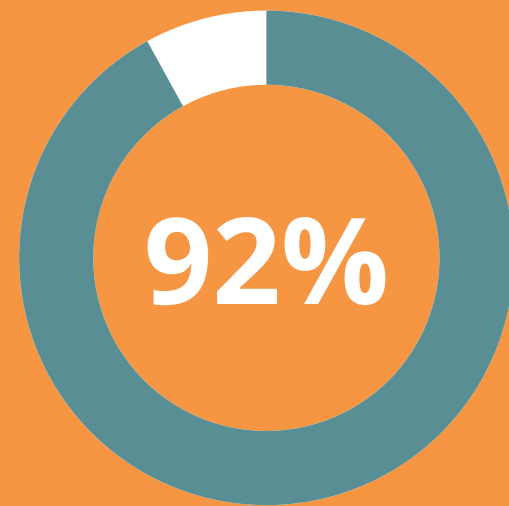


Housing 2021-22

These include drug and alcohol treatment, training courses, leisure activities, welfare and benefits, bills and budgeting, employment, physical and mental health, cultural activities, social and life skills, and family connections.

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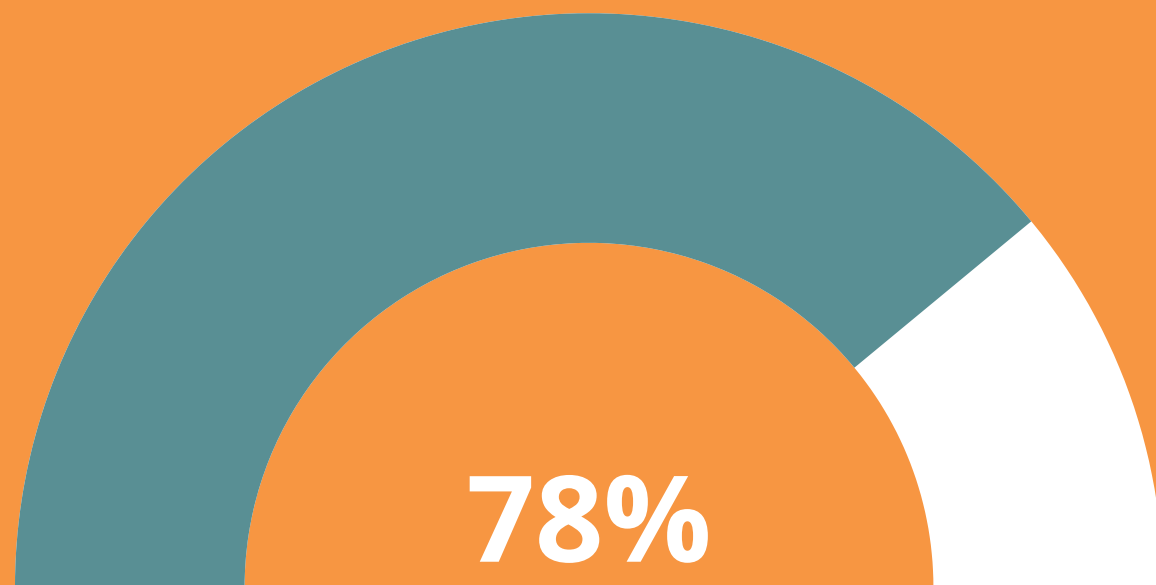
clients housed in our safe substance misuse Pathway 4 housing.
